JESUS DIED FOR YOU

WE ALL HAVE SINNED

Isaiah 53:6

All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

WE HAVE ALL FELL SHORT

Romans 3:23

For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard, and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God put forward as a **propitiation** by his blood, to be received by faith.

WE DIED WITH JESUS

(OUR OLD MAN DIED)

WE DIED WITH JESUS ON
THE CROSS

2 Corinthians 5:14

14 For the love of Christ controls us, because we have concluded this: that one has died for all, therefore **all have died**;

Galatians 2:20/Romans 6:6

I have been crucified with Christ and **I no longer live**, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God

WE DIED TO THE LAW

**BREAKING THE LAW
RESULTS IN DEATH**

**WE HAVE DIED TO THE LAW
(NO MORE LAW FOR US)**

Romans 6:23

“The wages of sin is death...”

(Therefore, we now have peace with the Law, having served our sentence)

Galatians 2:19

For through the law **I died to the law**, so that I might live to God.

WE DIED TO SIN (DEATH STATE)

OUR SIN NATURE DIED

(OUR OLD MAN DIED)

Romans 6:2

..How can we who died to sin still live in it? 3 Or are you unaware that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? 4 Therefore we were buried with Him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, **so we too may walk in a new way of life...** 6 For we know that our old self was crucified with Him in order that sin's dominion over the body may be abolished, so that we may no longer be enslaved to sin, 7 since a person who has died is freed from the body of sin.

WE ARE **RIGHTEOUS** THROUGH FAITH

FAITH JUSTIFIES US.

ABRAHAM JUSTIFIED THROUGH
FAITH

Galatians 2:16

yet we know that a person is not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be justified.

Romans 4:3

“Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness.” 4 Now to the one who works, his wages are not counted as a gift but as his due. 5 And to the one who does not work but believes in him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is counted as righteousness,

WE ARE **HOLY** THROUGH FAITH

HIS DEATH MADE US HOLY

Colossians 1:22

But now He has reconciled you by His physical body through His death, to present you **holy**, faultless, and blameless before Him— 23 **if indeed you remain grounded and steadfast in the faith** and are not shifted away from the hope of the gospel that you heard.

WE ARE HOLY

1 Peter 2:9

We are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a **holy** nation..

1 Corinthians 3:17-...God's sanctuary is **holy, and that is what you are**

but my steadfast love shall not depart from
you,

and my covenant of peace shall not be
removed,”

says the Lord, who has compassion on

CHRISTIANS DON'T GET **CHARGED** FOR SIN

DAVID'S PROPHETIC INSIGHT

Romans 8:4

How joyful are those whose lawless acts are forgiven
and whose sins are covered!
8 How joyful is the man
the Lord will never **charge** with sin!

GOD DOESN'T DEAL WITH US BASED ON US

Psalms 103

He will not always accuse us
or be angry forever.
10 He has not dealt with us as our sins deserve
or **repaid us according to our offenses**.
11 For as high as the heavens are above the earth,
so great is His faithful love (favor, kindness)
toward those who fear Him.
12 As far as the east is from the west,
so far has He removed
our transgressions from us.
13 As a father has compassion on his children,
so the Lord has compassion on those who fear Him.
14 For He knows what we are made of,
remembering that we are dust.

CHRISTIANS CONFESS & REPENT OF SINS

IF WE SIN, WE HAVE AN ADVOCATE

1 John 1:6-10

If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. 7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. 8 If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. 9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 10 If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

1 John 2:1-2

..if anyone does sin (disobey God), we have an advocate with the Father—Jesus Christ the righteous one. He himself is the propitiation (sacrifice) for our sins....and also for those of the world.

Matthew 6:12

Forgive us of our sins as we forgive those that trespass against us

JESUS SUMS UP THE LAW

Galatians 5:6

6 For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision counts for anything, but **only faith working through love**. (love of God and others)

John 15:12

12 "This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. 13 Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends. 14 You are my friends if you do what I command you.

NOW USE THIS TIME TO LOVE

DISCIPLES OF CHRIST LOVE
EACH OTHER

Galatians 5:13

For you were called to be free, brothers; only don't use this freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but serve one another through love. 14 For the entire law is fulfilled in one statement: Love your neighbor as yourself.

John 13:35

By this all people will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.”

HOW TO STAY SAVED

STAY IN THE VINE BY KEEPING FAITH

(STAY BELIEVING THE GOSPEL, STAY SAVED)

Romans 11:20

20 [many Jews] were broken off by unbelief, but **you stand by faith**. Do not be arrogant, but be afraid. 21 For if God did not spare the natural branches, He will not spare you either. 22 Therefore, consider God's kindness and severity: severity toward those who have fallen but God's kindness toward you—if you **remain in His kindness**. Otherwise you too will be cut off. 23 And even they, if they **do not remain in unbelief**, will be grafted in, because God has the power to graft them in again.
